## Needling consent form

**The intended benefits.** To use local anesthetic injection to numb the verruca/wart site, then repeatedly puncture the verruca/wart approximately 100 to 200 times to cause an immune response effect that causes the body's white blood cells to attack the virus.

The needled site will feel 'bruised' and sore for possibly one or several days following treatment.

Patients with a compromised immune system (i.e. MS, Lupus disease etc) will have a lower expected outcome and longer recovery time.

If any adverse effects are noted please contact me straight away.
